

## KLM JTTL: Draw and Play Offs Explanation

- Each Grade (A and B) is split into two pools – Pool 1 and Pool 2. This was selected randomly. The only criterion was to split teams from the same school/club evenly between pools.
- There are a total of 8 weeks of matches for all teams.
- Each pool will start with 5 weeks of round robin matches (play every team in your pool).
- If you have only 5 teams in your pool (12A, 12B and 16B) then you will play one extra match against one team in the other pool which is selected at random.
- All points each week are recorded including the match against the other team in the other pool (see below example). You will get one point for every match won, and bonus 2 points if you win the tie.

**Points Table Example for Pool with 5 Teams**

Team	A	B	C	D	E	Total
<b>A</b>	Score against team in other pool	6	8	3	6	30
<b>B</b>	2	Score against team in other pool	8	7	4	23
<b>C</b>	0	0	Score against team in other pool	0	0	1
<b>D</b>	5	1	8	Score against team in other pool	2	24
<b>E</b>	2	2	8	6	Score against team in other pool	19

- After 5 round robin weeks the top two teams (teams with the most points) in each pool will then form its own play off group for 2 weeks to decide the overall top 2 teams for the finals in week 8.

**Week 6 and 7**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Pool 1:** will play 1<sup>st</sup> Pool 2 and 2<sup>nd</sup> in Pool 2 (2 weeks of matches)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Pool 1:** will play 1<sup>st</sup> Pool 2 and 2<sup>nd</sup> in Pool 2 (2 weeks of matches)
- 1<sup>st</sup> Pool 2:** will play 1<sup>st</sup> Pool 1 and 2<sup>nd</sup> in Pool 1 (2 weeks of matches)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Pool 2:** will play 1<sup>st</sup> Pool 1 and 2<sup>nd</sup> in Pool 1 (2 weeks of matches)

**Week 8:**

**Finals:** Top Two teams with most points will play finals  
3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> teams will play off for 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> week 8.

- After 5 rounds the teams that finished 3<sup>rd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> (or 6<sup>th</sup> in 16A) will then form a round robin to decide placings.
- Each team will play 3 matches against the 3 teams in the opposing pool.
- After the 3 weeks of matches the teams will then have a ranking from 5<sup>th</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> place based on the number of points they have.
- (16A: will only play 3 of the 4 teams in the opposing pool. This will be randomly selected).

**12A and B and 16B:**
